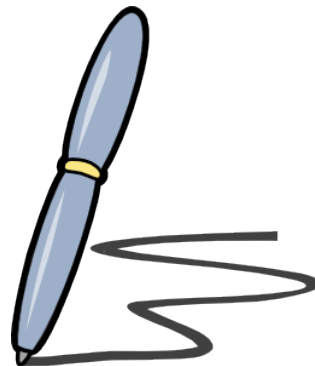
<b>2</b>	Add an <b>ing</b> suffix to one verb below to create an adjective.

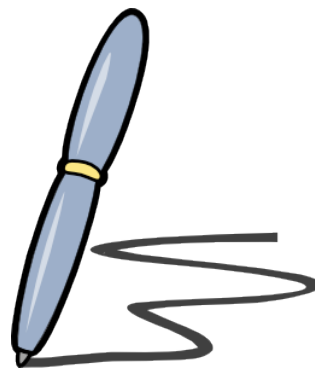
<b>3</b>	Add an <b>able</b> suffix to one verb below to create an adjective.

<b>c</b>	surprise	<b>d</b>	have



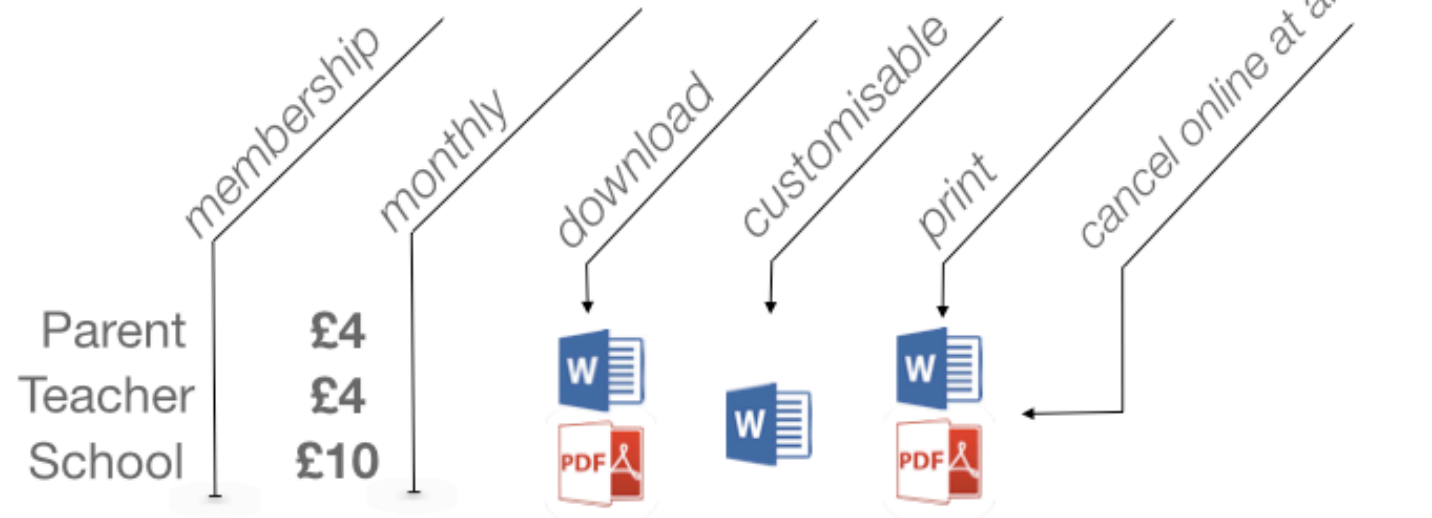
